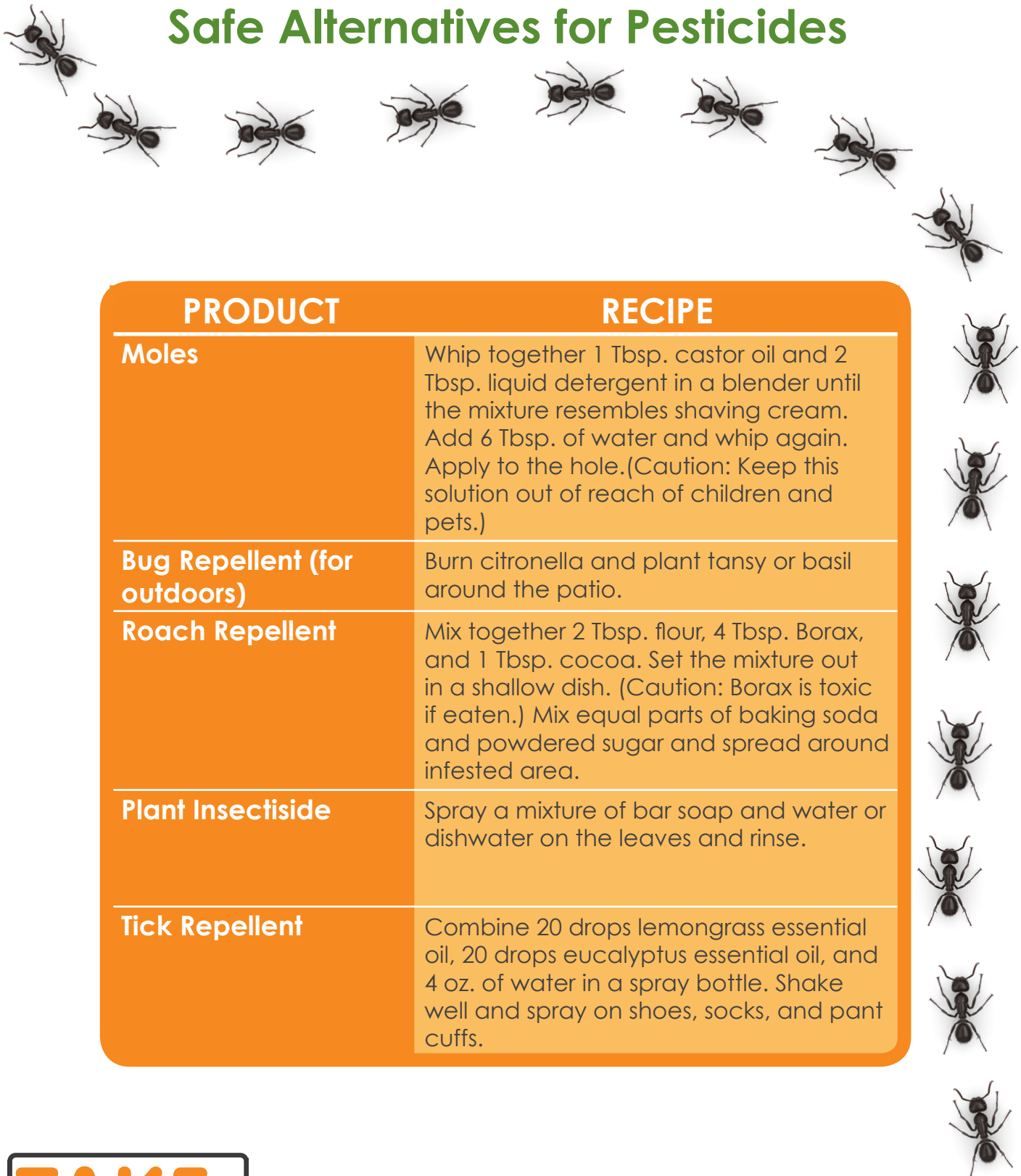


Safe Alternatives for Pesticides



PRODUCT	RECIPE
Moles	Whip together 1 Tbsp. castor oil and 2 Tbsp. liquid detergent in a blender until the mixture resembles shaving cream. Add 6 Tbsp. of water and whip again. Apply to the hole. (Caution: Keep this solution out of reach of children and pets.)
Bug Repellent (for outdoors)	Burn citronella and plant tansy or basil around the patio.
Roach Repellent	Mix together 2 Tbsp. flour, 4 Tbsp. Borax, and 1 Tbsp. cocoa. Set the mixture out in a shallow dish. (Caution: Borax is toxic if eaten.) Mix equal parts of baking soda and powdered sugar and spread around infested area.
Plant Insecticide	Spray a mixture of bar soap and water or dishwasher on the leaves and rinse.
Tick Repellent	Combine 20 drops lemongrass essential oil, 20 drops eucalyptus essential oil, and 4 oz. of water in a spray bottle. Shake well and spray on shoes, socks, and pant cuffs.
